Route 66 Hotel & Casino

Located 66 Casino & Hotel is located just off the historic Route 66 west of Albuquerque. It is owned and operated by the Pueblo of Laguna. With its 154-room hotel, multiple restaurants, lounges, and bars, the casino it is a popular destination, attracting numerous travelers and visitors.

CHALLENGE

Traditional cleaning methods are time-consuming, require extensive manpower, and often fall short in achieving comprehensive decontamination. In the aftermath of the pandemic, concerns about the safety of personnel, travelers, and visitors combined with staffing challenges led to the search for more effective and economical ways to respond to biological contamination.

SOLUTION

The TRT9000 decontamination system is suited for multi-story buildings larger than 7,500 square feet. The custom design ensures the system perfectly matches the specific requirement of the treatable areas. Automated precision evenly distributes a nontoxic, decontaminating dry mist, achieving consistent 100% coverage. After only 15 minutes, up to 99.999999% of bacteria, viruses, mold, and fungi are eliminated and VOCs, chemical toxins, odors, and allergens are neutralized. No additional wiping or rinsing is required which greatly enhances the efficiency of the decontamination process. At the end of the cycle, the dry mist is replaced with fresh air, allowing rooms to be reentered immediately to complete turnover protocols.

Decontamination cycles are completed in 15 minutes. No need for wiping or rinsing.
